PUBLIC POLICY & SOCIAL IMPACT CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The Public Policy and Social Impact Certificate Program is a 12-credit, UGC-aligned course jointly offered by the Centre for Indian Knowledge System and Innovation, Hansraj College (University of Delhi) and Bharatiya Neeti Samvad Kendra, a public policy think-tank based in New Delhi. Mapped to NSQF Level 6 and aligned with the NEP 2020, the program empowers aspiring public policy leaders through an interdisciplinary, field-immersive and data visualisation & analysis tools learning model grounded in Indian thoughts. Designed for students and professionals, it blends academic instruction with real-world exposure—offering online sessions, guided field immersions in rural/tribal, and urban settings, and workshops to train in public policy research, data tools, and community engagement. The course equips participants with skills in policy analysis, implementation, evaluation, and communication—preparing them for careers in governance, research, and development sectors. It is also eligible for Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), supporting academic mobility and career progression while bridging India's rural-urban divide through culturally grounded, evidence-based approaches.
